

Choppington Primary School – Children Survey.

October 2015

72 children responded (not EYFS).



Do you like coming to Choppington Primary School?	Yes - 96% No - 4%
Do you have some good friends at school?	Yes - 99% No - 1%
Do you feel safe in our school?	Yes - 95% No - 5%
Do you ever feel unsafe?	No - 79% Yes - In school 8% / Outside School - 13%
Is it important to come to school?	Yes - 99% No - 1%
Why do you like coming to school?	To work, play with friends. I love the teachers. I like writing and hard maths. It's fun. You learn new things. You learn lots and lots. It's nice. To get a good job. Times tables. Because we write. I love outside toys. Making special things.
Do the grown-ups in school listen to you?	Yes - 100%
Do you enjoy your lessons?	Yes - 99% No - 1%
Is behaviour in school generally good in classrooms and at playtime?	Yes - 78% No - 22%
Do you feel that you can help to make things better at our school through the School Council or if you tell a grown up?	Yes - 96% No - 4%
Choppington Primary School is a 'happy place to be'. How can we make it better?	Yr5&6 swimming. Line up smartly Listen to teachers. More assemblies. More after school clubs. Less fights. We could follow the Golden Rules. Longer playtimes. More dinner staff. Split yard for play. Have 2 headteachers. Chocolate on Fridays. No bullying. Tidy up and work hard.

We are pleased with the overall views of the pupils in this survey.

ACTIONS - I am asking children who were worried about behaviour to assist me with ideas for improvement. Year 5&6 go swimming in the Spring Term. We are splitting the playground now at lunchtimes, with separate playtimes for KS1 and KS2 in the mornings.
