COVID-19 Measures

happening.

We have been back for just over 2 weeks now and the children have settled well. On Thursday there was an announcement for the North East to have stricter lockdown regulations. At present this does not impact on school and we will continue with our COVID procedures to ensure we continue to keep everyone as safe as we can.

We need you to continue to support us during this difficult time and follow the guidelines and practices we have set out. These include:

Social distancing - whilst on the yard you need to keep your distance (2m) from others, especially near the KS2 gate. I do not want to follow the lead of other schools and insist on facemasks but you need to adhere to our practices. The boards on the yard are there to help remind you.

Class 'Bubbles' - when dropping off and collecting the children please make sure you use the correct gate and wait outside of the buffer zone. The buffer zone is to help with social distancing and safeguarding, making sure the children go to the correct parents etc.

One adult to pick up - only one adult per child/family is to collect from any door at any one time. There have been incidences where people have been in the incorrect yard or even people

on site whose children do not attend the school. We will politely remind you if we see this

Please continue to support us with the measures we have put in place, as we work through these uncertain times. We really do not want to have close parts of the school, resulting in the children being at home for another length of time. I am sure you don't want that either;)

Absence Reporting

If your child is going to be absent from school for any reason please make sure that you contact school to let us know. We have an answerphone service (option 1) which has been set up to help with this. Please leave a message and if we need to call back for more information then we will do so.

It is your responsibility to inform school if your child is going to be absent or late.

Changes to school timings

We have reviewed our practices over the past couple of weeks and have decided that we need to make changes to our school timings and procedures for drop-off and pick-up. Please read the following carefully:

** Breakfast club still starts at 8.15. Children enter through the KS2 Yard door.

We hope that these changes will make the morning and afternoon routine smoother and stop people from having to hang around too much and prevent crowding and lack of social distancing.

Please also remember the following:

- In accordance with Government Guidance, parents are not able to routinely enter the school building. (Parents should only enter school sites by advanced appointment)
- Parents and children are to wait, with 2m social distancing, on the yard for their child's entrance point. For exit please wait, with 2m distancing, we will release children to the parent/carer in the exit points. Please DO NOT wait on the pavement but on the school yard.
- Children on entry to school will wash their hands on entering and exiting the school.

- PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE TOO EARLY FOR DROP OFFS AND PICK UPS AS THIS MAY CAUSE CONGESTION. ADULTS TO KEEP 2M APART WHILST WAITING WITH YOUR CHILDREN
- To help with congestion we will be opening our class doors 5 minutes early to ensure that children can be dropped and left smoothly. This soft opening will help with the flow of children and allow it to be less busy.
- LATE ARRIVALS If your gate is closed you will need to bring your child to the Main Entrance and buzz for information this may require you to meet at your child's designated entrance.
